Those interested in applying should email an *Expression of Interest* to the <u>Head of School and the Research Facilitator</u> no later than **Monday 31 May 2021.** This should consist of a *single pdf document* (saved in the format: NIF-2021\_(surname\_firstname).pdf), containing the following information:

- 1. Research proposal, comprising:
  - a. The working title
  - b. A one-page summary of your proposed research
  - c. A statement outlining the relevance of your proposal to other work being carried out in the School
  - d. Details of any facilities (e.g. for scientific analyses) that would be required from the host institution during the Fellowship
- 2. A CV
- 3. A brief letter of support from the academic within the School who will support your application, and the project if your application is successful

All applications will be assessed on academic merit, the feasibility of the proposed research project and the extent to which the work fits with existing interests of the research cluster and the School. The School will also consider its research priorities and resource implications when reaching a decision.
