British Academy Postdoctoral Fellowship scheme 2023/2024 School of Archaeology – Expressions of Interest

Deadline for receipt of EOIs is 5pm on Monday 07 August 2023

The School of Archaeology welcomes interest from applicants to this scheme.

Before submitting an Expression of Interest, please check (contacting research@arch.ox.ac.uk) that the School is the most appropriate department through which to apply, especially if your field of research also intersects with other disciplines (e.g. Classics, Anthropology, etc.).

Submitting an Expression of Interest

The British Academy Postdoctoral Fellowships are highly competitive, and the School sets a limit on the number of applications that can be supported. We therefore run a selection and ranking exercise to identify those that we are able to support. This is unlikely to be more than three per round.

If you are interested in making an application, the first step is to identify a mentor who is an academic member of the School of Archaeology. Potential applicants should then submit a formal Expression of Interest (EoI) to the School by **5pm on Monday 07 August 2023**. The EoI should be sent as a <u>single pdf document</u> to <u>research@arch.ox.ac.uk</u>, and contain the following:

- 1. A summary of the intended project (maximum length 2 A4 pages). Candidates should ensure that this summary covers both the specific research questions of the project *and* its broader archaeological relevance. It should also address the feasibility of completing the project within the scheme's timeframe, and the project's fit to the School of Archaeology.
- 2. A list of what would be required from the host institution within the project (e.g. scientific analyses/facilities/equipment/space/supervision).
- 3. A CV.
- 4. A statement of support from the mentor within the School, indicating the relevance of the research to the broader interests of the School and their support of the proposal and applicant.

EoIs will be assessed and ranked on academic merit, the viability of the proposed research project and its feasibility at Oxford, and the extent to which the research fits within the interests of the School. The School will consider its research priorities and resource/space implications when reaching a decision.

Candidates who are invited to proceed to the full application stage will be required to submit a full draft to the School for review. Please note that we cannot guarantee that all applications will ultimately be approved for submission. Final applications must be submitted to the University's Research Services by Wednesday 27 September.
